The tables below outline how end of year grades will be awarded for all year groups.

Third Years

60%	Based on Mock result
20%	Based on teacher expectation and engagement in classroom work up to 12th March 2020. This may include an average of all assessments in 3rd year, engagement with CBA etc
20%	A piece of work or assessment completed between now and 25th May

1st – 5th Years

80%	Based on teacher expectation and engagement in classroom work up to 12th March 2020. This may include an average of all assessments in engagement in classwork, homework, assignments etc.
20%	A piece of work or assessment completed between now and 25th May
